

**RESOLUTION NO. 459 -2009, AMENDING THE 2009 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL 100% STATE AID FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF MENTAL HEALTH FOR SKILLS UNLIMITED, INC.**


**2<sup>nd</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute a contract with Skills Unlimited, Inc; and be it further
