**RESOLUTION NO. 463 -2009, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$358,500 FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT TERRORISM PREVENTION PROGRAM (SLETPP FFY2008) WITH 100% SUPPORT**

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Office of Homeland Security has made \$358,500 in Federal pass-through funds from the 2008 State Homeland Security Grant Program available to Suffolk County for the SLETPP FFY2008 Program to be administered by the Suffolk County Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, this program is designed to assist law enforcement in the prevention, deterrence and response to terrorist attacks; and

**WHEREAS**, the operational period of the program will be from September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, said grant funds have not been included in the 2009 Suffolk County Operating Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the SLETPP FFY2008 grant includes funding for the purchase of a heavy duty towing vehicle for the Suffolk County Police Department's Technical Services Section; now, therefore be it






