

RESOLUTION NO. -2009, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ENTER INTO AN INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF BROOKHAVEN IN CONNECTION WITH THE INSTALLATION AND REMOVAL OF BUOYS AT THE SMITH POINT MARINA AND CHANNEL ENTERING THE GREAT SOUTH BAY

WHEREAS, the Smith Point Marina and the channel entering the Great South Bay are used regularly by Suffolk County residents during the boating season; and

WHEREAS, navigational buoys are important to keeping boaters safe when entering and exiting marinas, bays and the ocean; and

WHEREAS, Smith Point Marina and the channel entering the Great South Bay have been without navigational buoys since 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Brookhaven and the County of Suffolk agree that it is in the best interest of Suffolk County residents to install navigational buoys at the marina and channel to protect the public's safety while on the water; and

WHEREAS, both the Town and the County wish to enter into an agreement whereby the County will purchase, store and maintain the buoys when they are removed each year and the Town will aid in the annual installation and removal of the buoys; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that, pursuant to Article 5-G of the NEW YORK STATE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW, the County Executive, or his designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute an Intermunicipal Agreement with the Town of Brookhaven whereby the County of Suffolk shall purchase, store and maintain the buoys described herein and the Town shall aid in the installation and removal of the buoys annually; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that the Intermunicipal Agreement and all other contract documents shall be subject to the approval of the County Attorney.
