

RESOLUTION NO. 515 -2009, AMENDING THE 2009 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE 100% ADDITIONAL STATE AID FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF MENTAL HEALTH FOR PERSONALIZED RECOVERY ORIENTED SERVICES (PROS) PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Mental Health has allocated additional 100% State Aid to Personalized Recovery Oriented Services (PROS) Programs; and

WHEREAS, these additional funds represent implementation of the PROS Supplemental Employment Funding initiative; amounts determined by and to be used in accordance with the PROS Supplemental Employment Funding guidelines; and

WHEREAS, this additional 100% State Aid from the New York State Office of Mental Health is not currently included in the 2009 Adopted Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$425,999 in additional 100% State aid as follows:


2nd **RESOLVED**, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute a contract with each of the above-named provider agencies; and be it further
