

**RESOLUTION NO. 616 -2009, AUTHORIZING WAIVER OF INTEREST AND PENALTIES FOR PROPERTY TAX FOR EDWARD NEDWICK AND CARMEN BETANCOURT (SCTM NO. 0500-077.00-04.00-040.000)**

**WHEREAS**, Edward Nedwick and Carmen Betancourt are the owners of a parcel of real property located at 9 Lacey Lane, Central Islip, NY, bearing Suffolk County Tax Map (SCTM No. 0500-077.00-04.00-040.000); and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Islip advises and represents that the Town did not send a tax bill to Edward Nedwick and Carmen Betancourt in a timely fashion which led to the late payment of their property taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 30 of the SUFFOLK COUNTY TAX ACT, this Legislature may waive penalties and interest for the late payment of taxes under these circumstances; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that this Legislature hereby authorizes the Suffolk County Treasurer, pursuant to Section 30 of the SUFFOLK COUNTY TAX ACT, to accept the amount of \$3,820.29 in full payment of taxes for the 2008-2009 tax year from the property owners without payment of the interest charges and penalty charges in the amount of \$38.20 for a parcel in Central Islip, New York, bearing SCTM No. 0500-077.00-04.00-040.000:



**3rd RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21), and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
