**RESOLUTION NO. 659 -2009, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FEDERAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000 FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, OFFICE OF INSPECTOR GENERAL, FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE'S SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (SNAP) AND WELFARE FRAUD INVESTIGATION WITH 85.14% SUPPORT**

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of Agriculture, Office of Inspector General, has made \$15,000 in Federal funding available to Suffolk County for participation of the Suffolk County Police Department in the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and welfare fraud investigation; and

**WHEREAS**, said project involves participation with the Department of Agriculture in an operation involving the enforcement and investigation of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and Welfare Fraud; and

**WHEREAS**, the operational period of the project is from October 1, 2008 through September 8, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, said reimbursement funds have not been included in the 2009 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said reimbursement funding as follows:


