

RESOLUTION NO. 665 -2009, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FEDERAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,000 FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES, FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE ATF TASK FORCE WITH 85.14% SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, has made \$16,000 in Federal funding available to Suffolk County for participation of the Suffolk County Police Department in the ATF Task Force; and

WHEREAS, said project is part of a multi-agency task force designed to assist ATF in investigations and enforcement of Federal, State, and Local Laws; and

WHEREAS, the operational period of the Program is from October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, said reimbursement funds have not been included in the 2009 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said reimbursement funding as follows:


