WHEREAS, the Kiwanis Club of Greater Westhampton will host its annual fundraising carnival August 13, 2009 through August 16, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Kiwanis Club of Greater Westhampton has submitted to Gabreski Airport a request to utilize property for the purposes of this event; and


WHEREAS, the Department of Economic Development and Workforce Housing and the Airport Conservation and Assessment Panel (ACAP) have reviewed this application and recommend the Legislature approve this request with a fee of \$400 per day; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his designee, be and hereby is authorizing to execute a license agreement for the use of the above described property between the Kiwanis Club of Greater Westhampton and the County of Suffolk, in substantial accordance with the agreement annexed; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") New York Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Volume 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") §617.5 (c)(15), (20), and (27), in that the resolution concerns minor temporary uses of land having negligible or no permanent impact on the environment.
