**RESOLUTION NO. 786 -2009, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$433,506 IN 100% GRANT FUNDING FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF TEMPORARY AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES FOR THE TRANSITIONAL JOBS PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance has designated Suffolk County as the recipient of Federal funding in the amount of \$433,506; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of this grant is to provide temporary subsidized employment opportunities to individuals in receipt of TANF and Safety Net MOE Assistance; and

**WHEREAS**, subsidized employment can serve as an important component of any district's employment services by offering an effective placement for individuals lacking an adequate or demonstrated work history, who have other barriers to employment or when employment opportunities in the community are limited; and

**WHEREAS**, these subsidized employment opportunities may be provided for up to one year in transitional positions; and

**WHEREAS**, this funding will also be utilized to provide case management and job placement and retention services to promote permanent employment; and

**WHEREAS**, this program is 100% federally funded; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of Suffolk County to accept these funds; now, therefore be it


