**RESOLUTION NO. 882 -2009, AMENDING THE 2009 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL STATE AID FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES AND TO TRANSFER FUNDING FROM CURRENT APPROPRIATIONS TO HUMAN GROWTH AND UNDERSTANDING SEMINARS, INC. (HUGS)**

**WHEREAS**, the approved New York State budget for Fiscal Year 2009 includes funding in Aid to Localities to support the provision of chemical dependence, prevention, gambling prevention and treatment programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services, (OASAS) has increased the 2009 base allocation in State Aid by \$45,000 to the Human Growth and Understanding Seminars, Inc. (HUGS) prevention program; and

**WHEREAS**, this additional State Aid, along with the additional local share of \$25,000 supports the range of HUGS prevention services including coordination of and sustaining the Westhampton community coalition and additional space costs associated with the program's relocation; and

**WHEREAS**, this \$25,000 in unallocated funding is already included in the 2009 Adopted Operating Budget and needs to be transferred to HUGS, Inc.; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$45,000 in additional State Aid as follows:


