

Introduced by Presiding Officer pursuant to Rule 3(A)(14) of the Suffolk County Legislature

**RESOLUTION NO. 1173 -2009, APPROVING RATES
ESTABLISHED FOR RONCALLI FREIGHT COMPANY INC.**

WHEREAS, Roncalli Freight Company Inc. has applied to the Suffolk County Legislature, by a Petition dated and verified September 29, 2009 and by an Amended and Restated Petition dated and verified November 25, 2009, pursuant to Article 8 of the Navigation Law and Section 71 of the Transportation Corporations Law of the State of New York and Local Law No. 7 of 1982 of Suffolk County for the establishment of freight rates; and

WHEREAS, the office of Legislative Budget Review has submitted its recommendations on said application to this Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Public Transportation Committee of this Legislature has reported its recommendations on the application to the Legislature as a whole; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the Amended and Restated Petition of Roncalli Freight Company Inc. dated and verified as of November 25, 2009 is approved; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that subject to Roncalli Freight Company Inc. filing with the Clerk of the Suffolk County Legislature on or before June 30, 2010 (i) documentation indicating that Middle-Earth Holdings LLC, an affiliate of Roncalli Freight Company Inc., has acquired that certain parcel of land known as 68 River Road, Sayville, New York, being the land upon which the freight business will be located (including the Sayville, New York landing site) and that such property has been transferred to Middle-Earth Holdings LLC, (ii) the consent of Middle-Earth Holdings LLC authorizing Roncalli Freight Company Inc. to utilize the Sayville landing site, and (iii) documentation indicating that the ownership to the ferry boat known as the MN Provider, O.N. 1190836, 14 gross tons, has been transferred to Roncalli Freight Company Inc., the Freight Tariff Rates are approved as follows:


