**RESOLUTION NO. 1119 -2009, APPROVING AN AMENDED
TREATMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN SUFFOLK COUNTY
SEWER DISTRICT NO. 8 – DORADE AND DORADE, LLC FOR
A RATE INCREASE**

WHEREAS, Dorade, LLC is the owner and operator of the Dorade Wastewater Treatment Plant, servicing SCSD No. 8, and the County of Suffolk has an agreement to discharge 50,000 gallons per day of wastewater to the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, the original agreement dated January 1, 1999 and revised September 7, 2000, permitted Dorade, LLC after a term of five years to request an increase in sewage treatment fees; and


WHEREAS, more than nine years have elapsed since the adoption of the original Treatment Agreement and after a request to increase the rates by Dorade, LLC, the Suffolk County Agency at the April 20, 2009, meeting approved the request from Dorade, LLC to increase the rate; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Agency on January 26, 2009, approved a retroactive payment of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) for the year 2008, and on April 20, 2009, approved an annual increase of the rate of Twenty-Three Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Nine Dollars (\$23,859.00), thereby increasing the 2009 rate to One Hundred Ten Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Nine Dollars (\$110,859.00), and thereafter an increase that is consistent with the typical district rate increases of three percent (3%), now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the Administrative Head of the District be and he hereby is authorized, directed, and empowered to enter into an amended Treatment Agreement with Dorade, LLC to approve an increase in the wastewater treatment rate in SCSD No. 8.


