**RESOLUTION NO. 1130 -2009, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS (CP 3301)**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioner of Public Works has requested funds for land acquisition in connection with Safety Improvements at Various Locations; and

**WHEREAS**, there are sufficient funds within the 2009 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994 and as amended by Resolution No. 461-2006 has established a priority ranking system as the basis for funding Capital Projects such as this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$180,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, Resolution Nos. 1013-1996, 592-2001 and 529-2003 approved by the County Legislature constitute unlisted actions pursuant to the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR, Part 617 and Chapter 279 of the Suffolk County Code, and that the proposed intersection improvements will not have a significant effect on the environment; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty-one (51) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

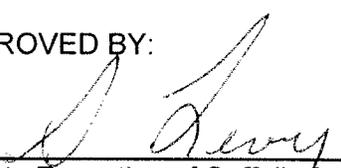
**3<sup>rd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take such action as may be necessary to complete Safety Improvements at Various Locations, pursuant to Section C8-2 (A) of the Suffolk County Charter; and be it further

**4<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$180,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
