

RESOLUTION NO. 1223 -2009, AMENDING THE 2009 CAPITAL BUDGET AND PROGRAM AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS ON VARIOUS COUNTY ROADS (CP 5497)

WHEREAS, pedestrian safety becomes increasingly important as more people walk for their health or forego automobile use to economize on the use of fuel; and

WHEREAS, upgrading and increasing the sidewalk systems on County roads is an important part of the efforts to promote pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, all conditions precedent to the financing of the Capital Projects hereinafter described, including compliance with the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act have been performed; and

WHEREAS, that this Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$816,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 571-1998, Resolution No. 209-2000 and Resolution No. 461-2006 established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2008 Capital Budget, as the basis for funding Capital Projects such as this project; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act Environmental Conservation Law Article 8 (hereinafter "SEQRA"), Resolution No. 946-2009 and Resolution No. 947-2009 classified the actions contemplated by this as Type II Actions, which will not have a significant effect on the environment; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty-one (51) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 571-1998, Resolution No. 209-2000 and Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that the 2009 Capital Budget and Program be and is hereby amended as follows:


