

**RESOLUTION NO. 1215 -2009, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 75% FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NYS OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$150,000 FOR THE "FY2009 INTEROPERABLE EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS GRANT PROGRAM" (IECGP) ADMINISTERED BY THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF FIRE, RESCUE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Office of Homeland Security has awarded Suffolk County 75% Federal pass-through funds from the US Dept of Homeland Security (DHS) Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) under the FY 2009 Interoperable Emergency Communications Grant Program (IECGP) program to be implemented by the Suffolk County Department of Fire, Rescue & Emergency Services; and

**WHEREAS**, the IECGP FY2009 will provide funds to improve interoperable emergency communications in Suffolk County for response to significant emergencies, acts of terrorism and natural disasters; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant is for a twenty-four (24) month period in which the County will receive 75% grant funding in the amount of \$150,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the IECGP FY2009 is slated to operate for the period beginning 06/01/2009 to 05/31/2011; and

**WHEREAS**, said funds have not been included in the 2009 Operating Budget; and the required 25% matching local funds (\$50,000) have been included in Capital Program 3230.510 and/or 3416.510; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>ST</sup> RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21), (25) and (27) of the Title 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the New York Environmental Conservation Law as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council of Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution; and be it further

**2<sup>ND</sup> RESOLVED**, the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept \$150,000 and appropriate said grant funds as follows:


