

RESOLUTION NO. 1154 -2009, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% STATE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE HEALTHY COMMUNITIES CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Health has awarded 100% State grant funds to the Department of Health Services for the Healthy Communities Capacity Building Program in the amount of \$34,000 for the period 08/01/09-03/31/10; and

WHEREAS, this program will build capacity and support local efforts to reduce chronic disease by addressing physical activity and nutrition; and

WHEREAS, this grant will now allow State Aid reimbursement of \$8,192 for appropriations (001 - HSV - 4500) already included in the 2009 Suffolk County Budget with the balance of \$25,808 to be appropriated; and

WHEREAS, these funds are 100% State funded; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept the grant award of \$34,000 and to appropriate \$25,808 as follows:




