RESOLUTION NO. 1159 -2009, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FEDERAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,000 FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, U.S. MARSHALS SERVICE, FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE REGIONAL FUGITIVE TASK FORCE WITH 85.14% SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice, U.S. Marshals Service, has made \$16,000 in Federal funding available to Suffolk County for participation of the Suffolk County Police Department in the Regional Fugitive Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the operational period of the program is from October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, said reimbursement funds have not been included in the 2009 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said reimbursement funding as follows:


