

**RESOLUTION NO. 1161 -2009, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FEDERAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,000 FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES, FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE ATF TASK FORCE WITH 85.14% SUPPORT**

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, has made available an initial amount of \$16,000 in Federal funding available to Suffolk County for participation of the Suffolk County Police Department in the ATF Task Force; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal agency may award additional funding during the Federal Fiscal Year, the Suffolk County Police Department is accepting funds in an amount equal to the total claims for the prior year; and

**WHEREAS**, said project is part of a multi-agency task force designed to assist ATF in investigations and enforcement of Federal, State, and Local Laws; and

**WHEREAS**, the operational period of the Program is from October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, said reimbursement funds have not been included in the 2009 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said reimbursement funding as follows:


