**RESOLUTION NO. -2010, INCREASING THE PETTY
CASH FUND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Department of Social Services maintains petty cash accounts at eight service sights and an additional fund authorized for the Child Support Enforcement Bureau, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 60-1996 authorized the petty cash fund for the Department of Social Services in the amount of \$8,500.00 and authorized the petty cash fund for the Child Support Enforcement Bureau in the amount of \$3,000.00 effective January 23, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the department utilizes its petty cash accounts to meet immediate needs for such recipients as those served by Adult Protective Services, Emergency Services, Client Benefit centers, Representative Payees, Fair Hearings, Food Allowances, Emergency Clothing and a variety of other purposes; and

WHEREAS, these amounts are no longer adequate to meet the current needs of the petty cash functions within the department; and

WHEREAS, there has not been an increase in the Department's Petty Cash Fund since 1996; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to increase the Petty Cash Fund account of the Department of Social Services from \$8,500.00 to \$25,000.00 effective immediately.
