**RESOLUTION NO. 152 -2010, AUTHORIZING  
EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE  
HEAD OF SUFFOLK COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 11 -  
SELDEN WITH THE OWNER OF SEELEY SUBDIVISION (BR-  
1567)**

**WHEREAS**, Seeley Subdivision is located outside the boundary of Suffolk County Sewer District No. 11 - Selden; and

**WHEREAS**, the owner of Seeley Subdivision has petitioned and requested the Administrative Head of the District for permission to connect into the sanitary sewers of the Sewer District No. 11 - Selden; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined by the Administrative Head of the District that the District has wastewater treatment capacity available in excess of its own needs; and

**WHEREAS**, the connection is subject to the approval of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC); and

**WHEREAS**, it will be financially beneficial to Suffolk County Sewer District No. 11 - Selden and Suffolk County, as well as in the environmental interest of all of Suffolk County, for the connection to be made; and

**WHEREAS**, such connection has been approved by the Suffolk County Sewer Agency, Resolution No. 42-2009; and

**WHEREAS**, Seeley Subdivision will pay \$7.06 per gallon per day (\$8,472.00) of the connection fee to the District 11 Venture as part of the agreement for expanding the District and the balance of the \$15.00 connection fee (\$7.94) per gallon per day (\$9,528.00) to the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Sewer Agency has determined that pursuant to Section 617.5 (c), (11), & (20), of the SEQRA regulations, this project is listed as a Type II Action, and requires no further action; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that pursuant to Section 617.5(c) (11) and (20), of the SEQRA regulations, this project is a Type II Action, and requires no further action; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup> RESOLVED**, that the Administrative Head of the District be and he hereby is authorized, directed and empowered to enter into contracts and agreements with the developer upon such terms and conditions as he may deem necessary relating to connections to the District of lands adjacent to Suffolk County Sewer District No. 11 - Selden and that they be required to post a surety bond or bonds and deposit cash or securities with the County Treasurer in those instances that the Administrative Head deems necessary to ensure performance of such agreements and contracts.
