**RESOLUTION NO. 140 -2010, AUTHORIZING USE OF  
CATHEDRAL PINES COUNTY PARK BY BABYLON BREAST  
CANCER COALITION FOR ITS MOUNTAIN BIKE RIDE  
FUNDRAISER**

**WHEREAS**, the Babylon Breast Cancer Coalition would like to use Cathedral Pines County Park for its Mountain Bike Ride fundraiser; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mountain Bike Ride is scheduled to be held on Sunday, March 14, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, a Certificate of Insurance naming Suffolk County as an additional insured has been provided by Babylon Breast Cancer Coalition; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that the use of Cathedral Pines County Park by Babylon Breast Cancer Coalition for the purpose of hosting a fundraiser on Sunday, March 14, 2010, is hereby approved pursuant to Section 215(1) of the NEW YORK STATE COUNTY LAW, subject to the receipt of a Certificate of Insurance and the accompanying declaration page by the County of Suffolk from Babylon Breast Cancer Coalition, and the payment of the One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) event fee, and subject to such additional terms and conditions as may be required by the Risk Management and Benefits Division in the County Department of Human Resources, Personnel and Civil Service; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup> RESOLVED**, that before this event shall be permitted to occur, Babylon Breast Cancer Coalition must apply for and obtain a permit from the Commissioner of the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Conservation as required by Section 378-7(B) of the Suffolk County Code; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup> RESOLVED**, that the Commissioner of the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, pursuant to Section 28-4(A) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER, to take such measures as shall be necessary and appropriate to facilitate the hosting of the fundraiser at Cathedral Pines County Park by Babylon Breast Cancer Coalition; and be it further

**4<sup>th</sup> RESOLVED**, that Babylon Breast Cancer Coalition shall also provide an entertainment promoter certificate to Suffolk County if it wishes to allow vendors at the event to sell tangible personal property other than food or drink and require these vendors to display such certificate in order to comply with the provisions of the NEW YORK TAX LAW; and be it further

**5<sup>th</sup> RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), New York Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Volume 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") §617.5(c)(15), (20), and (27), in that the resolution concerns minor temporary uses of land having negligible or no permanent impact on the environment, routine, or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities, and adoption of a

local legislative decision in connection with the same, and, since this is a Type II action, the County Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA.
