**RESOLUTION NO. 438 -2010, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FEDERAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,903 FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION, FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE SAFE STREETS TASK FORCE FY2010 WITH 83.37% SUPPORT**

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Investigation, has made \$16,903 in Federal funding available to Suffolk County for participation of the Suffolk County Police Department in the Safe Streets Task Force FY2010; and

**WHEREAS**, said project is part of a multi-agency task force designed to assist the Federal Bureau of Investigation in investigations and enforcement of Federal, State, and Local Laws; and

**WHEREAS**, the operational period of the Program is from October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, said reimbursement funds have not been included in the 2010 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it
