

**RESOLUTION NO. 430 -2010, AUTHORIZING USE OF  
CATHEDRAL PINES COUNTY PARK BY THE LEAGUE FOR  
ANIMAL PROTECTION OF HUNTINGTON FOR ITS "RIDE  
LAPS FOR L.A.P." FUNDRAISER**

**WHEREAS**, the League for Animal Protection of Huntington is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization having its place of business at P.O. Box 390, Huntington, New York; and

**WHEREAS**, the League for Animal Protection of Huntington would like to use Cathedral Pines County Park in Middle Island for the purpose of hosting its "Ride Laps for L.A.P." fundraiser; and

**WHEREAS**, the "Ride Laps for L.A.P." fundraiser is scheduled to be held on Sunday, June 13, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, a Certificate of Insurance naming Suffolk County as an additional insured will be provided by the League for Animal Protection of Huntington within 30 days of the "Ride Laps for L.A.P." fundraiser; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the use of Cathedral Pines County Park by the League for Animal Protection of Huntington for the purpose of hosting a fundraiser on Sunday, June 13, 2010, is hereby approved pursuant to Section 215(1) of the NEW YORK STATE COUNTY LAW, subject to the receipt of a Certificate of Insurance and the accompanying declaration page by the County of Suffolk from the League for Animal Protection of Huntington, and the payment of the One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) event fee, and subject to such additional terms and conditions as may be required by the Risk Management and Benefits Division in the County Department of Human Resources, Personnel and Civil Service; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that before this event shall be permitted to occur, the League for Animal Protection of Huntington must apply for and obtain a permit from the Commissioner of the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Conservation as required by Section 378-7(B) of the Suffolk County Code; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the Commissioner of the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, pursuant to Section 28-4(A) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER, to take such measures as shall be necessary and appropriate to facilitate the hosting of the fundraiser at Cathedral Pines County Park by the League for Animal Protection of Huntington; and be it further

**4<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the League for Animal Protection of Huntington shall also provide an entertainment promoter certificate to Suffolk County if it wishes to allow vendors at the event to sell tangible personal property other than food or drink and require these vendors to display such certificate in order to comply with the provisions of the NEW YORK TAX LAW; and be it further

**5<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), New York Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant

to Volume 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") §617.5(c)(15), (20), and (27), in that the resolution concerns minor temporary uses of land having negligible or no permanent impact on the environment, routine, or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities, and adoption of a local legislative decision in connection with the same, and, since this is a Type II action, the County Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA.
