**RESOLUTION NO. 399-2010, APPOINTING MEMBER TO THE
LOCAL HOME ENERGY EFFICIENCY TASK FORCE (KEVIN
HARVEY)**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 965-2009 established a Local Home Energy Efficiency Task Force to study and analyze the feasibility of the towns in Suffolk County participating in programs to improve the energy efficiency of homes in their towns; to share information on current programs established by the various towns that seek to improve home energy efficiency; and to research funding available at the State and Federal levels for such programs; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 965-2009 provides that two representatives of the labor industry, selected by the County Legislature, shall be members of the task force; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that Kevin Harvey is hereby appointed as one of the representatives of the labor industry on the Local Home Energy Efficiency Task Force pursuant to Resolution. No. 965-2009, for a term of office to expire December 31, 2010; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
