

**RESOLUTION NO. 585 -2010, APPROPRIATING FUNDS  
IN CONNECTION WITH THE ACQUISITION OF AN UPGRADED  
PAYROLL SYSTEM DATABASE (CP 1740)**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioner of Information Technology has requested the appropriation of funds in connection with the Analysis of the County Payroll System to collect information about the existing application, business requirements, technical requirements, and document a detailed project plan; and

**WHEREAS**, once completed, the design phase will bring together information gathered from the analysis phase to form the Upgraded Payroll System Database; and

**WHEREAS**, there are sufficient funds within the 2010 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request and it has been reviewed and approved by the Information Processing Steering Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006, established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2010 Capital Budget as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date within, has authorized the issuance of \$ 250,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (C) (20) and (21) and of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), in that the law authorizes routine or continuing agency administration and management; information collection, including basic data collection and research, and preliminary engineering planning processes necessary to formulate a proposal for an action, but does not commit the County to commence or approve an action; since this law is a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of sixty (60), is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of the \$250,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and are hereby appropriated as follows:
