

**RESOLUTION NO. 603 -2010, AMENDING THE 2010  
ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND  
APPROPRIATE 100% UNALLOCATED STATE AID FROM THE  
NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF MENTAL HEALTH TO  
VARIOUS AGENCIES**

**WHEREAS**, there remains \$57,520 in unallocated 100% State Aid from the New York State Office of Mental Health; and

**WHEREAS**, Suffolk County contracts with several agencies which currently provide programs within the parameters of the Office of Mental Health's 2010 Spending Plan Guidelines; and

**WHEREAS**, the Division of Community Mental Hygiene Services (Division) requests allocation of these funds to existing providers; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$57,520 in unallocated State Aid as follows:
