**RESOLUTION NO. 734 -2010, REAPPOINTING ROBERT J.

WHEREAS, the term of office of **Robert J. Hartmann**, expires as of July 31, 2010; now, therefore, be it

1st RESOLVED, that **Robert J. Hartmann**, currently residing at 3895 Sound Avenue, Riverhead, New York, 11901, be and he hereby is reappointed to the Suffolk County Vocational, Education, and Extension Board for a term of office to expire on July 31, 2019, said appointment having been made pursuant to the provisions of Section 1101(2) of the NEW YORK EDUCATION LAW.

- The Vocational Education Extension Board (VEEB) of the County of Suffolk is the agency charged with providing fire training for the volunteer fire departments of Suffolk County as well as to certain contract agencies doing business in the County. The Board is comprised of nine members who serve a nine-year term, with the term of one Board member expiring each year.
- Co-Founder of the St. James Sportsman Club in 1962, and currently serves as president of the organization
- Served numerous years as an officer of the New York State Potato Club and the Long Island Farm Bureau
- Past president and currently serving as an officer of Long Island Cauliflower Association
- Active in the St. John and Evangelist Church in Riverhead, where he served as an usher for the last 32 years
- Joined the Plainview Fire Department in 1952, became assistant foreman
- Joined the St. James Fire Department in 1954 and spent many years participating with the St. James "Wildcats" drill team
- 1967: Sold the farm and moved to farms in Riverhead
- Retired from farming, Robbie stays active with his commitment to VEEB and the fire service of Suffolk County
