

**RESOLUTION NO. 804 -2010, APPROVING THE
CONSOLIDATION OF THE PILGRIM PSYCHIATRIC CENTER
VITAL REGISTRATION DISTRICT 5196 AND THE TOWN OF
ISLIP VITAL REGISTRATION DISTRICT 5154**

WHEREAS, the Registrar of the Town of Islip and the Executive Director of Pilgrim Psychiatric Center have agreed to consolidate Pilgrim Psychiatric Center Primary Registration District 5196 with the Town of Islip Primary Registration District 5154 for vital statistics into one primary registration district of the Town of Islip; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 4120(2)(a) of PUBLIC HEALTH LAW, such action is subject to the approval of the Suffolk County Legislature; and

WHEREAS, based upon approval from the Suffolk County Legislature, the New York State Commissioner of Health may issue an order combining the districts; now, therefore be it


1st RESOLVED, that upon the request of the Registrar of the Town of Islip and Pilgrim Psychiatric Center, the Suffolk County Legislature hereby approves the consolidation and combination of the Pilgrim Psychiatric Center Primary Registration District 5196 and the Town of Islip Primary Registration District 5154 into the Town of Islip Registration District, subject to the approval of New York State Commissioner of Health; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this resolution of the New York State Commissioner of Health, the Supervisor of the Town of Islip, the Clerk of the Town of Islip, Pilgrim Psychiatric Center Vital Statistics Registration District, the County Attorney of Suffolk County, and the Suffolk County Public Health Director; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
