

**RESOLUTION NO. 788 -2010, MAKING A SEQRA DETERMINATION IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROPOSED CEDAR POINT COUNTY PARK MASTER PLAN, TOWN OF EAST HAMPTON**

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) has reviewed a project designated as the "Proposed Cedar Point County Park Master Plan, Town of East Hampton", pursuant to Section 6 of Local Law No. 22-1985 the project Cedar Point County Park Master Plan includes the following:

- Reconfigure existing campsites and roadways
- Create primitive campsites
- New Active recreational facilities
  - a. basketball court
  - b. (2) volleyball/badminton courts
  - c. Canoe/kayak launch area
- Sign Plan
- Relocate/replace camp store (2,000sf)
- Improve/renovate existing bathrooms
- Replace/reconfigure campground check-in (400sf) building and park entrance
- Construction of nature center (4,100sf)
- Construction of new bathroom (1,550sf)
- Construction of three (3) composting toilet stations (10x10)
- Construction of viewing platforms
- Reconstruction of rowboat cabin (10x15)
- Restore Cedar Island Lighthouse
- Upgrade existing utilities (fuel, water, sanitary, electric, phone)
- Demolish several failing, underutilized structures
- Consolidate maintenance facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, an Environmental Assessment Form (EAF) was prepared and submitted to the CEQ Office by the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation and subsequently sent out to all concerned parties; and

**WHEREAS**, at its June 16, 2010 meeting, the CEQ reviewed the EAF and information submitted by the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation; and

**WHEREAS**, the CEQ recommended that the above activity be considered a Type I action, pursuant to the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR, Part 617.4(b)(1) and Chapter 279 of the Suffolk County Code, as this action involves the adoption of a municipality's land use/comprehensive resource management plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the CEQ has advised the County Legislature and the County Executive by memo dated June 17, 2010 of said recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 279-5(H) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE requires the Presiding Officer to introduce legislation for an appropriate SEQRA determination; and

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Legislature has reviewed the EAF and the CEQ recommendations; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that this Legislature hereby determines that the Proposed Cedar Point County Park Master Plan, Town of East Hampton constitutes a Type I action, pursuant to the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR, Part 617.4(b)(1) and Chapter 279 of the Suffolk County Code, which project will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment for the following reasons:

- 1) The proposed action will not exceed any of the criteria in Section 617.7 of Title 6 NYCRR, which sets forth thresholds for determining significant effect on the environment;
- 2) The proposal does not appear to significantly threaten any unique or highly valuable environmental or cultural resources as identified in or regulated by the Environmental Conservation Law of the State of New York or the Suffolk County Charter and the Suffolk County Code;
- 3) All necessary Federal, State, County and local permits will be obtained; and
- 4) The proposed Master Plan improvements will enhance recreational activities within the Cedar Point County Park;


and be it further

**3rd RESOLVED**, that in accordance with Section C1-4(1)(d) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER and Section 279-5(C)(4) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE, the CEQ is hereby directed to prepare and circulate a SEQRA notice of determination of non-significance in accordance with this Resolution.
