RESOLUTION NO. 816 -2010, AMENDING THE 2010 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO REALLOCATE FUNDING FOR A NEW INITIATIVE, THE G.R.E.A.T. PROGRAM IN THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1299-2007 included \$45,500 in the Probation budget for recidivism reduction among inmates leaving the Jail; and

WHEREAS, the Probation Department has a balance of \$8,910 remaining in 001-PRO-3197-4560 2010 funds which were reallocated for the Gang prevention and training Conferences; and

WHEREAS, these additional funds of \$8,910 are not needed at this time for one of the Gang Conferences; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to fund overtime for officers to run the Gang Resistance Education and Training (G.R.E.A.T.) program which ceased operating in 2010 due to ending of the grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the funds required to run the G.R.E.A.T. Program for 2010 do not exist within the 2010 Operating Budget, and funds are available for transfer and will allow for the continuation of the G.R.E.A.T. Program; and

WHEREAS, the use of these additional funds of \$8,910 for the G.R.E.A.T. program have been approved by the Justice department; now therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Legislature be and hereby amend the Adopted 2010 Operating Budget as follows:


