

**RESOLUTION NO. 817 -2010, ACCEPTING THE  
DONATION OF A 2010 VOLVO XC60 ON BEHALF OF THE  
SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, seatbelts are an important part of motor vehicle safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Police Department educates the public concerning the importance of seatbelt safety through educational presentations using the "Convincer" to show residents of Suffolk County the importance of wearing seatbelt restraints; and

**WHEREAS**, a need exists within the Suffolk County Police Department for a vehicle which will be used as a tow vehicle for the "Convincer" to said educational presentations; and

**WHEREAS**, Volvo Cars of North America, LLC along with the Long Island Volvo Retailer Group seeks to donate a 2010 Volvo XC60 All Wheel Drive Sport Utility Vehicle, VIN YV4992DZ7A2026860, with a retail value of forty one thousand five hundred dollars (\$41,500.00) to the Suffolk County Police Department's Highway Patrol Bureau as a tow vehicle for the "Convincer"; and

**WHEREAS**, according to the terms of the proposed donation, the 2010 Volvo XC60 must bear the Volvo logo and the names of the participating retailers on the exterior of the vehicle, in addition to the official police markings; and

**WHEREAS**, such corporate names and logo shall be placed on the rear windows using lettering consistent with lettering on other donated vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Police Department has recommended that said gift be accepted; now, therefore be it


