

RESOLUTION NO. 1216-2010, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH RESTORATION OF FACADES AT THE SUFFOLK COUNTY VANDERBILT MUSEUM (CP 7441)

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Suffolk County Vanderbilt Museum has requested construction funds to restore damaged, unstable and unsafe building facades at the Suffolk County Vanderbilt Museum; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds within the 2010 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request; and

WHEREAS, this Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$300,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 571-1998, Resolution No. 209-2000 and Resolution No. 461-2006 established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2010 Capital Budget, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of thirty-eight (38) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 571-1998, Resolution No. 209-2000 and Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$300,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they hereby are appropriated as follows:

3rd **RESOLVED**, that the County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take such action as may be necessary, pursuant to restore damaged, unstable and unsafe building facades at the Suffolk County Vanderbilt Museum; and be it further

4th **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that the adoption of this law is a Type II action, pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(C) (21), (22) and (27), since it constitutes a local legislative decision in connection with the maintenance, repair, replacement, rehabilitation, reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building or fire codes. As a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA.

Dear Presiding Officer Lindsay and Members of the Legislature:

I am returning herein **Resolution Numbers 1216, 1217 – 2010; APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH RESTORATION OF FACADES AT THE SUFFOLK COUNTY VANDERBILT MUSEUM (CP 7441)** vetoed in its entirety.

While many 2010 budgetary line items have been drastically reduced in order to provide necessary government services and hold the line on property taxes during a fiscal crisis, providing funding to repair facades within a currently unsustainable facility is not a smart use of taxpayer's dollars. The Vanderbilt Museum was directed to establish a concrete plan towards becoming a self-sufficient facility, yet we still find the museum in perilous financial condition. We must maintain control over our spending in this area.

For these reasons, I strongly urge the Legislature to sustain my veto of this resolution.
