

**RESOLUTION NO. 13 -2011, AUTHORIZING THE SALE,
PURSUANT TO LOCAL LAW NO. 16-1976, OF REAL
PROPERTY ACQUIRED UNDER SECTION 46 OF THE
SUFFOLK COUNTY TAX ACT FLORENCE FAZIO (SCTM NO.
0908-007.00-01.00-034.000)**

WHEREAS, the COUNTY OF SUFFOLK acquired the following described parcel:

ALL, that certain plot, piece or parcel of land, with any buildings and improvements thereon erected, situate, lying and being in the Town of Southampton, County of Suffolk, and State of New York, described on the Tax Map of the Suffolk County Real Property Tax Service Agency as District 0908, Section 007.00, Block 01.00, Lot 034.000, and acquired by tax deed on May 3, 2010, from Angie M. Carpenter, the County Treasurer of Suffolk County, New York, and recorded on May 5, 2010, in Liber 12623, at Page 992, and otherwise known and designated by the Town of Southampton, as Lot No. 2 on a certain map entitled "Map of Windrift Estates" and filed in the Suffolk County Clerk's Office on May 11, 1977 as Map No. 6545; and

FURTHER, notwithstanding the above description, it is the intention of this conveyance to give title only to such property as was acquired by the County of Suffolk by Tax Deed on May 3, 2010, from Angie M. Carpenter, the County Treasurer of Suffolk County, New York, and recorded on May 5, 2010 in Liber 12623 at Page 992.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Suffolk County Local Law No. 16-1976, provision has been made for the sale of such real property acquired by the County through tax sale; and

WHEREAS, FLORENCE FAZIO has made application of said above described parcel and FLORENCE FAZIO has paid the application fee and has paid \$25,384.01, as payment of taxes, penalties, interest, recording fees, and any other charges due the County of Suffolk, pursuant to Local Law, by applicant, through November 30, 2010; now, therefore be it


1st **RESOLVED**, this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that adoption of this law is not an action within the meaning of the State Environmental Quality Review Act and the regulations adopted thereto. See 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Section 617.2(b) (2). The Legislature further finds and determines that even if the adoption of the local law is an action within the meaning of SEQRA, the adoption of law is a Type II action constituting a legislative decision in connection with routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priority. See 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Section 617.13(d) (15) and (21). As a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Section 617.5(a)(1); and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that the Director of the Division of Real Property Acquisition and Management, and/or her designee, be and she hereby is authorized to execute and acknowledge a Quitclaim Deed to FLORENCE FAZIO, 69 Old Barn Lane, Sagaponack, NY 11962, to transfer the interest of Suffolk County in the above described property and on the above described terms.
