**RESOLUTION NO. 99 -2011, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF REPLACEMENT VHF MOBILE RADIOS FOR AMBULANCE VEHICLES AND DESKTOP RADIOS FOR HOSPITALS (CP 4080)**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioner of Health Services has requested the appropriation of funds in connection with the purchase of replacement VHF mobile radios for ambulance vehicles and desktop radios for hospitals; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to purchase these replacement radios to comply with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) requirements, based on the Association of Public Communications Officials Project 25 requirements for the Public Radio Spectrum frequency allocation to maintain emergency medical service related communication; and

**WHEREAS**, there are sufficient funds within the 2011 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request under Capital Program Number 4080; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$400,600 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994 as amended by Resolution No. 453-2009 has established a priority ranking system as the basis for funding Capital Projects such as this project; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty-one (51) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 and as amended by Resolution No. 453-2009; and be it further


**2<sup>nd</sup> RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (c) 20, 21, 25 and 27 of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), in that the resolution concerns purchasing of furnishings, equipment and supplies, other than land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides or other hazardous materials, and adoption of a local legislative decision in connection with the same, and the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup> RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$400,600 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they hereby are appropriated as follows:
