

**RESOLUTION NO. 247-2011, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN
CONNECTION WITH RECONSTRUCTION OF CULVERTS
(CP 5371)**

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has requested funds for construction services for the reconstruction of County Culverts; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds within the 2011 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994 and as amended by Resolution No. 461-2006 has established a priority ranking system as the basis for funding Capital Projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, this Legislature reviewed projects of this nature under a previous version of the implementing rules and regulations of SEQRA and determined by Resolution No. 1168-1995 that the reconstruction of culverts constitutes a Type II action; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$868,250 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(1), (2) (20) and (27) of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), in that the law authorizes information collection, including basic data collection and research, and preliminary planning processes necessary to formulate a proposal for an action, but does not commit the County to commence or approve an action, and since the action involves a legislative decision concerning the maintenance, repair, replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure in kind, on the same site, since this law is a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of thirty-three (33) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further


3rd **RESOLVED**, that the County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take such action as may be necessary to complete the Reconstruction of Culverts, pursuant to Section C8-2 (A) of the Suffolk County Charter; and be it further

4th **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$868,250 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
