

RESOLUTION NO. 497 -2011, AMENDING THE 2011 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO TRANSFER 100% STATE AID FUNDING FROM SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES TO THE PEDERSON-KRAG CENTER, INC. AND TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE 100% ADDITIONAL STATE AID FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES TO BRENTWOOD UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, New York State Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (NYS OASAS) has authorized a one-time transfer of \$55,000 in 100% State Aid already included in the Department of Health Services 2011 Adopted Operating Budget to Pederson-Krag Center, Inc. for prevention staffing; and

WHEREAS, NYS OASAS has also allocated additional one-time funding of \$2,400 in 100% State Aid to the Brentwood Union Free School District for evidence based training materials; and

WHEREAS, this additional 100% State Aid is not included in the 2011 Adopted Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

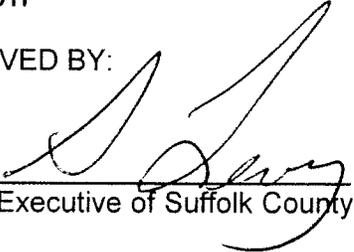
