

RESOLUTION NO. 500 -2011, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NYS DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FOR THE 2009 HazMat GRANT PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF FIRE, RESCUE & EMERGENCY SERVICES AND TO EXECUTE GRANT RELATED AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services has awarded Suffolk County Federal funds under the 2009 HazMat Grant Program to be implemented by the Suffolk County Department of Fire, Rescue & Emergency Services; and

WHEREAS, the 2009 HazMat Grant Program will provide funds to the Department of Fire, Rescue & Emergency Services to promote the development of regional partnerships among the County HazMat community; to build sustainable WMD/HazMat Response and Decontamination Capabilities; and to enhance the standing of the County's HazMat teams within FEMA's "typing system"; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Fire, Rescue & Emergency Services will utilize this funding to partner with the Towns of Babylon, Brookhaven, East Hampton, Islip and Southampton, the Brookhaven National Laboratory and SCPD to conduct a Radioactive/Chemical Material Contamination Exercise; a combined "Team Only" Technical Decontamination Drill and update of the County Emergency Management Plan Appendix K-County HazMat Plan; and

WHEREAS, this grant is for a thirty-six (36) month period from 8/01/2009 through 7/31/2012 in which the County will receive 100% grant funding in the amount of \$100,000 for the 2009 HazMat Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, said funds have not been included in the 2011 Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept \$100,000 and appropriate said grant funds as follows:



WHEREAS, the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services has approved a grant modification to utilize said funding for identified stop gap measures; now, therefore be it



RESOLUTION NO. 783 -2013, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NYS OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY (NYS OHS) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$135,000 FOR "OPERATION SHIELD" UNDER STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM (SHSP) TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE SUFFOLK COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE EAST END MARINE TASK FORCE, SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT, SUFFOLK COUNTY PARK POLICE AND VARIOUS OTHER FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL AGENCIES, AND TO EXECUTE GRANT RELATED AGREEMENTS WITH 100% SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Homeland Security has awarded the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office \$135,000 in funds under the SHSP grant program to be administered by the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, the SHSP will provide funds for high visibility maritime enforcement for prevention and response to terrorist attacks, and to minimize danger of and support recovery from terrorist attacks; and

WHEREAS, this grant provides funding for a minimum of two operations, one in July and one in September; the Sheriff's Office will receive 100% grant funding in the amount of \$135,000; and

WHEREAS, the SHSP is slated to operate for the period beginning 09/01/2012 to 06/30/2014; and

WHEREAS, said funds have not been included in the 2013 Operating Budget; now, therefore be it


