RESOLUTION NO. 573 -2011, ACCEPTING \$135,933 IN FEDERAL PASS THROUGH GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NYS DEPARTMENT OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PROBATION FOR THE S.T.O.P. VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN ACT PROGRAM WITH 100% SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services has awarded to Suffolk County \$135,933 in Federal funds under the S.T.O.P. Violence Against Women Act Grant Program for the period 08/01/10 – 07/31/11; and

WHEREAS, the funds allow for the continuation of existing services and will enhance the collaborative project between Suffolk County and the community based organizations addressing sexual assault and domestic violence through a coordinated effort; and

WHEREAS, the S.T.O.P. Violence Against Women Act Funds are used to continue the efforts of the Police and the following community agencies: VIBS Family Violence & Rape Crisis Center, Suffolk County Coalition Against Domestic Violence, Brighter Tomorrows, Inc., and The Retreat, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, grant funds totaling \$117,752 and grant revenue totaling \$111,646 have already been included in the 2011 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, grant funds totaling \$18,161 has been provided to include Brighter Tomorrows as a contract agency which has not been included in the 2011 operating budget and \$24,287 in grant revenue has not been included in the 2011 Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said grant funds as follows:


