

RESOLUTION NO. 712-2011, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE RECONSTRUCTION OF CR 13, FIFTH AVENUE/CR 13A, CLINTON AVENUE FROM THE VICINITY OF NYS ROUTE 27A, MONTAUK HIGHWAY TO THE VICINITY OF SPUR DRIVE NORTH, TOWN OF ISLIP (CP 5538)

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has requested funds for construction in connection with Intersection Improvements to CR 13, Fifth Avenue/CR 13A, Clinton Avenue from the Vicinity of NYS Route 27A, Montauk Highway to the Vicinity of Spur Drive North; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds within the 2011 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994 and as amended by Resolution No. 461-2006 has established a priority ranking system as the basis for funding Capital Projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$1,700,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, Resolution No. 1010-2009, approved by the County Legislature, declared this project constituted an unlisted action that will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment, therefore, the provisions of SEQRA have been complied with and no further environmental review is necessary; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of forty-six (46) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further


3rd RESOLVED, that the County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take such action as may be necessary to complete Intersection Improvements to CR 13, Fifth Avenue/CR 13A, Clinton Avenue from the Vicinity of NYS Route 27A, Montauk Highway to the Vicinity of Spur Drive North, pursuant to Section C8-2 (A) of the Suffolk County Charter; and be it further
