**RESOLUTION NO. 966 -2011, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% GRANT FUNDING FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF TEMPORARY AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES FOR THE CONTINUATION OF SERVICES PROVIDED UNDER THE COMMUNITY SOLUTIONS FOR TRANSPORTATION PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND THE COMMISSIONER OF SOCIAL SERVICES TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT**

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance has designated the Suffolk County Department of Social Services as the recipient of 100% Federal funding in the amount of \$96,234 to continue the Community Solutions for Transportation Project (CST10) to provide transportation services to TANF and Safety Net families and Non-Temporary Assistance (NTA) recipients who are employed and eligible under the 200% of poverty guidelines; and

**WHEREAS**, there are unspent funds from the Community Solutions for Transportation (CST10) Project allocation in the amount of \$27,935 that are still available for use through June 30, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the grant is to provide funds to enable TANF, SN-MOE and NTA families to secure and maintain employment where alternate means of transportation are unavailable; and

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Office of Temporary Disability Assistance has previously approved the grant proposal developed in collaboration with the Education and Assistance Corporation (EAC) as the provider of the Community Solutions for Transportation Project, and

**WHEREAS**, EAC will assess an individual's transportation needs and develop a plan which will enable the individual to secure new employment or continue existing employment thereby promoting self-sufficiency and financial independence; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of Suffolk County to accept these funds; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to accept the following funds:

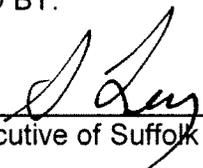
