

RESOLUTION NO. 969 -2011, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR A 100% U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FUNDED GRANT TO SERVE TANF AND LOW INCOME RECIPIENTS WITH JOB TRAINING SKILLS

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services has awarded a grant in the amount of \$1,002,021 to the Suffolk County Department of Labor to fund a TANF funded Training Employment Program; and

WHEREAS, the allowable activities under this Grant include On-The-Job training, Vocational training and other employment related activities; and

WHEREAS, funds were not included in the Suffolk County Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, funds were awarded in the amount of \$1,002,021; and

WHEREAS, these funds are 100% Federally funded; now, therefore be it




