

RESOLUTION NO. 1125 -2011, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMPTROLLER AND COUNTY TREASURER TO TRANSFER EQUIPMENT AND APPROVING AN INCREASE OF TWO VEHICLES IN THE FLEET FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, the NYS OCFS has discontinued Detention Prevention funding for the Timothy Hill Aftercare Program; and

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Department of Social Services has determined that due to the loss of funding, the program should be closed; and

WHEREAS, the attached "Addendum 1" hereby made part of this resolution specifies the equipment and vehicles purchased with County and State funds as part of this program's operation; and

WHEREAS, staff in the Department of Social Services' Family and Children's Services Administration (FCSA) uses vehicles 24 hours per day to effectively meet various statutory and regulatory requirements including child removals, placements, supervised visitations and court hearings; and

WHEREAS, in 2010, this department paid mileage reimbursement of \$507,114 to employees for over one million miles driven with their personal vehicles; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Suffolk County Department of Social Services to reallocate these vehicles to meet various statutory and regulatory requirements while reducing the rate of mileage reimbursement paid to employees; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Suffolk County to accept these vehicles; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept the following vehicles:

2nd RESOLVED, that the transfer of two (2) vehicles shall be accepted by the County of Suffolk for use by the Department of Social Services, FCSA; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that County's Public Works Department, Division of Fleet Management is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to fuel and maintain these vehicles bearing VIN No. 3GNBAADB6AS578404, and VIN No. 3GNBAADB3AS578585; and be it



4th **RESOLVED**, that the County Legislature hereby authorizes the fleet of the Suffolk County Department of Social Services, be increased by two (2) vehicles approved pursuant to Chapter 186-2(b)(6) of the Suffolk County Code, and in accordance with or exceeding the County Vehicle Standards, for use by Family Children and Adult Services; and be it further

5th **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Volume 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") Section 617.5 (25) and (27), in that the resolution concerns purchasing of furnishing, equipment and supplies, other than land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides or other hazardous materials, and adoption of a local legislative decision in connection with the same.


