

RESOLUTION NO. 1105 -2011, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH RENOVATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF FACILITIES AT GABRESKI AIRPORT (CP 5702)

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Department of Economic Development and Workforce Housing has requested funds for the Renovation and Construction of Facilities at Francis S. Gabreski Airport (CP 5702); and

WHEREAS, these funds will allow the Department to renovate the interior and exterior of the Airport Terminal Building; more specifically new roofing, siding, parking, and interior wall and ceiling repairs; and

WHEREAS, the 2011 Adopted Capital Budget and Program includes funds to cover the full cost of said request under Capital Project 5702; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006, has established a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2011 Capital Budget, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$200,000 in Suffolk County Gabreski Airport Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(c)(1)(2) (20)(27), in that this legislative decision involves continuing agency administration and management for the maintenance, repair, replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility in kind on the same site involving no substantial changes in the existing structure or facility, as such, the County has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty-nine (59) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that the Department of Economic Development and Workforce Housing pursuant to Section 42-3 (A) of the Suffolk County Charter, and the Department of Public Works pursuant to Section C8-2 (X) of the Suffolk County Charter are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take such action as may be necessary to complete this project; and be it further

4th **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$200,000 in Suffolk County Gabreski Airport Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
