

RESOLUTION NO. 1214-2011, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH THE REPLACEMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FLEET MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT (CAPITAL PROGRAM NUMBER 1769)

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has requested funds for the Replacement of Public Works Fleet Maintenance Equipment; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds within the 2011 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006, established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2011 Capital Budget, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$100,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (25)(C) (2), (11), (20), (21), (25) and (27) of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), in that the resolution concerns purchasing of furnishings, equipment and supplies, other than land, radioactive material, pesticides, herbicides or other hazardous materials, and adoption of a local legislative decision in connection with the same; and the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of twenty-three (23) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further



Dear Presiding Officer Lindsay and Members of the Legislature:


I am returning herein **RESOLUTION NO. 1214 – 2011, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH THE REPLACEMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FLEET MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT (CP 1769)**; vetoed in its entirety.

The executive branch made a policy determination to scale back the capital budget to deal with the difficult economic conditions we face. Major infrastructure was given priority in order to spur economic development, but other items that might have breezed through in better years, were delayed.

The legislature often says that the capital budget doesn't authorize spending, it merely creates a plan. However by placing every item in the budget up for authorization, it shatters that concept and eliminates any form of prioritization in order to control debt service levels.

For these reasons, I strongly urge the Legislature to sustain my veto of this resolution.


