

**RESOLUTION NO. 122-2012, MAKING A SEQRA DETERMINATION IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROPOSED SUFFOLK COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 3 – SOUTHWEST, TRUCK SCALE AT BERGEN POINT WWTP (CP 8180), TOWN OF BABYLON**

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) has reviewed a project designated as the "Proposed Suffolk County Sewer District No.3 – Southwest, Truck Scale at Bergen Point WWTP (CP 8180), Town of Babylon", pursuant to Section 6 of Local Law No. 22-1985 which project involves the construction of a truck scale in order to more efficiently track and record the removal of sludge cake from the facility and deliveries of a variety of materials that came to other sites. The plant access road will be modified and widened while keeping it as far as possible from adjacent wetlands. All necessary DEC permits will be obtained; and

**WHEREAS**, an Environmental Assessment Form (EAF) was prepared and submitted to the CEQ office by the Suffolk County Department of Public Works and subsequently sent out to all concerned parties; and

**WHEREAS**, at its January 18, 2012 meeting, the CEQ reviewed the EAF and information submitted by the Suffolk County Department of Public Works; and

**WHEREAS**, the CEQ recommended that the above activity be considered an unlisted action, pursuant to the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR, Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the CEQ has advised the County Legislature and the County Executive by memo dated January 19, 2012 of said recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 279-5(H) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE requires the Presiding Officer to introduce legislation for an appropriate SEQRA determination; and

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Legislature has reviewed the EAF and the CEQ recommendations; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that this Legislature hereby determines that the Proposed Suffolk County Sewer District No.3 – Southwest, Truck Scale at Bergen Point WWTP (CP 8180), Town of Babylon constitutes an unlisted action, pursuant to the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR, Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, which project will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment for the following reasons:

- 1) The proposed action will not exceed any of the criteria set forth in Title 6 NYCRR, Part 617.7, which sets forth thresholds for determining significant effect on the environment, as demonstrated in the Environmental Assessment Form;
- 2) The proposal does not significantly threaten any unique or highly valuable environmental or cultural resources as identified in or regulated by the

Environmental Conservation Law of the State of New York or the Suffolk County Charter and Suffolk County Code;

- 3) The parcel does not appear to suffer from any severe environmental development constraints (limiting soil properties; no high groundwater and no unmanageable slopes);
- 4) All necessary NYSDEC permits will be obtained;
- 5) A vegetated swale and drywell will be constructed to handle runoff; and
- 6) Any stockpiling of soil will have silt fencing or hay bales surrounding it;



**3rd RESOLVED**, that in accordance with Section C1-4(1)(d) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER and Section 279-5(C)(4) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE, the CEQ is hereby directed to prepare and circulate a SEQRA notice of determination of non-significance in accordance with this Resolution.
