**RESOLUTION NO. 72 -2012, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH GRANT FUNDS FROM THE NYS OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OF THE NYS DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45,966 FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CITIZEN CORPS COUNCIL (SC CCC) FY 2010 AND TO EXECUTE GRANT RELATED AGREEMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Office of Emergency Management has awarded to Suffolk County - Department of Fire, Rescue and Emergency Services - \$45,966 in grant funds to improve the effectiveness of citizen response during times of natural or man-made disaster; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds will be used to ensure minimal loss of life and property through a nationwide initiative calling for volunteer citizens to assist in homeland defense; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds will continue the work funded by Resolution Nos. 768-2003; 545-2004; 1218-2005; 1183-2006; 136-2008 and 292-2010 and performed by the Suffolk County Citizen Corps Council (created by Resolution No. 1283-2004) initiating and guiding the Suffolk County Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program, the Suffolk County Volunteers in Police Service (VIPS) program, and the Suffolk County Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) program; and

**WHEREAS**, this is a grant program beginning August 1, 2010 to July 31, 2013 in which the County will receive one hundred percent grant funding in the amount of \$45,966, and

**WHEREAS**, \$17,043 of said funds have been included in the 2012 Operating Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, \$28,923 of said funds have not been included in the 2012 Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept \$45,966, including \$17,043 included in the 2012 Operating Budget (001-FRE-3400-1100) and appropriate said grant funds as follows:
