RESOLUTION NO. 67 -2012, AMENDING THE 2012 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE 100% STATE AID FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES TO DAYTOP VILLAGE, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY TREATMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (OASAS) has allocated 100% State Aid funding to Daytop Village, Inc. effective January 1, 2012 in the amount of \$552,972 for the provision of Chemical Dependency Treatment Services; and

WHEREAS, Daytop Village, Inc. is an existing provider of OASAS Services and was previously funded under a direct contract through the OASAS New York City Regional office; and

WHEREAS, the Calendar Year 2012 State Aid Funding Authorization Letter will reflect the annual base State Aid funding to support the Part 822 Chemical Dependence Programs located in Huntington and an additional location at the William Floyd School District in Mastic Beach; and

WHEREAS, this additional 100% State Aid from NYS OASAS is not currently included in the 2012 Adopted Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$552,972 in additional State Aid as follows:


2nd RESOLVED, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute a contract with Daytop Village, Inc.; and be it further
