**RESOLUTION NO. 120 -2012, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT AWARD FROM THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK FOR A COMMUNITY COLLEGE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM FOR A CONSORTIUM PROJECT: AUDIOVOX, GPSI, AND WILBAR INTERNATIONAL 88% REIMBURSED BY STATE FUNDS AT SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

**WHEREAS**, Suffolk County Community College has received a grant award from the State University of New York, in the amount of \$43,908, including indirect costs, for a Community College Workforce Development Training Grant Program for a Consortium Project: Audiovox, Generic Pharmaceutical Services, Inc. (GPSI) and Wilbar International for the period of October 6, 2011 through August 15, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, a cash match in the amount of \$6,000 to be shared equally by each of the three consortium companies will increase the program total to \$49,908, including indirect costs; and

**WHEREAS**, the program will provide for a unique matrix of training classes aimed at developing the consortium internal talent in the areas of Microsoft Office Skills, Business Writing Skills, Basic Math Skills, Supervision/Management, Quality Assurance and English Language Skills; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Suffolk County Community College accepted the grant on December 1, 2011 by Resolution No. 2011.79; and

**WHEREAS**, the College anticipates spending the \$49,908, including indirect costs, in accordance with the terms of said grant award before August 15, 2012; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that said grant award from the State University of New York, for a Community College Workforce Development Training Grant Program for a Consortium Project: Audiovox, GPSI, and Wilbar International, in the amount of \$43,908, including \$5,033 in indirect costs, be accepted; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup> RESOLVED**, that a cash match in the amount of \$6,000, to be shared equally by Audiovox, GPSI, and Wilbar International, be accepted for the operation of the Community College Workforce Development Training Grant Program for the Consortium Project: Audiovox, GPSI, and Wilbar International; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup> RESOLVED**, that said program, in the amount of \$49,908, including \$5,033 in indirect costs, be appropriated for the operation of the project as follows:


