RESOLUTION NO. 121 -2012, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT AWARD FROM THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK FOR A COMMUNITY COLLEGE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM FOR ONESOURCE DOCUMENT MANAGEMENT, INC. 82% REIMBURSED BY STATE FUNDS AT SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

WHEREAS, Suffolk County Community College has received a grant award from the State University of New York, in the amount of \$11,183, including indirect costs, for a Community College Workforce Development Training Grant Program for OneSource Document Management, Inc. for the period of October 6, 2011 through August 15, 2012; and

WHEREAS, a cash match in the amount of \$2,500 provided by OneSource Document Management, Inc. will increase the program total to \$13,683, including indirect costs; and

WHEREAS, the program will provide funds for train-the-trainer services in Medical Record Components, Handling Claims Files, Requesting Files Legally, HIPAA (Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act) Authorization and HIPAA/Health Claims Control Systems for selected employees of OneSource Document Management, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Suffolk County Community College accepted the grant on December 1, 2011 by Resolution No. 2011.78; and

WHEREAS, the College anticipates spending the \$13,683, including indirect costs, in accordance with the terms of said grant award before August 15, 2012; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that said grant award from the State University of New York, for a Community College Workforce Development Training Grant Program for OneSource Document Management, Inc., in the amount of \$11,183, including \$1,375 in indirect costs, be accepted; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that a cash match from OneSource Document Management, Inc. in the amount of \$2,500 be accepted for the operation of the Community College Workforce Development Training Grant Program for OneSource Document Management, Inc.; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that said program, in the amount of \$13,683, including \$1,375 in indirect costs, be appropriated for the operation of the project as follows:

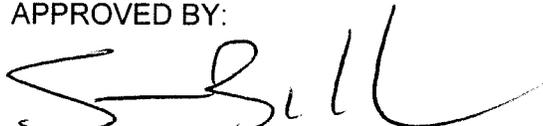
