

**RESOLUTION NO. 154-2012 AMENDING PRIOR CAPITAL
AUTHORIZED APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE PARTIAL
RENOVATION OF THE PECONIC BUILDING (CP 2181)**

WHEREAS, Bond Authorizing Resolution No. 203-2011 and Appropriating Resolution No. 202-2011 approved funding in connection with the Partial Renovation of the Peconic Building on the Eastern Campus of Suffolk County Community College; and

WHEREAS, a redistribution of funds is needed to complete the construction phase of the project; and

WHEREAS, the amount of funding that exists in the furniture and equipment phase can be used to complete the construction phase; and

WHEREAS, there is no net effect on the total cost of the project; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Resolution No. 202-2011 by deleting \$260,000 (\$130,000 serial bonds and \$130,000 State Aid) from the furniture and equipment budget and by adding \$260,000 (\$130,000 serial bonds and \$130,000 State Aid) to the construction budget; therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the 3rd Resolved clause of Resolution No. 202-2011 is hereby amended by changing the appropriation as follows:


